Code of Conduct for Coaching U18s



Anyone coaching U18s must:

- Ensure that every child is <u>accompanied at all times</u> by his or her parent or other Responsible Adult nominated by the child's parent.
- Avoid being alone with a child and avoid direct physical contact.
- Never leave a child unaccompanied.
- > Ensure a ratio of at least one U18s licensed coach for no more than 16 children.
- ➤ Ensure a safe ratio of Coaches/Coaching Assistants to children, normally 1:4.
- Respect the wishes of the child or parent if they do not wish to be photographed / videoed.
- > Ensure that all images are appropriate and available to the parent or immediately deleted afterwards.
- > Never publish an image of a child, without the appropriate written permission from the parent.
- > Obtain written permission from their parent before communicating directly with the child outside the coaching activity and ensure all such communication is both appropriate and transparent to the parent.
